HUCKLEBERRY FINN. A TRIP TOWARDS FREEDOM

This story develops throughout the Mississippi river, on a wooden raft in the middle of the nature. Huck, a naughty and smart boy who escapes from a violent and heavy drinker father, joins the fugitive slave Jim to get freedom together. Throughout this trip towards freedom they meet several typical characters of the southern society: Judith, a battered woman by his violent husband, the rude and lazy sheriff, the trickster Duke, ...

Although the idea that the author of the play, Mark Twain, has about the society he shows was a little bit pessimistic, Firewalk Theatre proposes an optimistic view, where the values of friendship, solidarity and the desire of freedom beat the racism, the abuse and the intolerance.

It is an adaptation of a great adventure novel which has got high values. As Ernest Hemingway said: "All the modern American literature comes from Huck-



leberry Finn by Mark Twain. Before that there was nothing. Since then, there has been nothing so good".

This play counts on two actors and a sound and lighting technician.

HUCKLEBERRY FINN. UN VIAJE HACIA LA LIBERTAD.

La historia se desarrolla a lo largo del río Mississippi, sobre una balsa de madera, en plena naturaleza. Huck, un muchacho pijo y espabilado que escapa de un padre violento y alcohólico, se une al esclavo huido Jim para conseguir la libertad juntos. A lo largo de ese viaje hacia la libertad se encontrarán con diversos personajes de la sociedad sureña: Judith, una mujer maltratada por un violento marido, el indolente y rudo Sheriff, el embaucador duque Bridgwater...

Aunque la mirada que tiene el autor Mark Twain de la sociedad es algo pesimista, Firewalk Theatre propone una visión optimista donde los valores de la amistad, la solidaridad y las ansias de libertad vencen al racismo, maltrato e intolerancia.

Es una adaptación de una gran novela de aventuras con grandes valores. Como dijo Ernest Hemingway: "Toda la literatura moderna estadounidense procede de Huckleberry Finn de Mark Twain. Antes no hubo nada. Desde entonces, no ha habido nada tan bueno."
